Ryan White Consumer Forum-Service Category Definitions

- a) Outpatient/Ambulatory Medical Care: Seeing a doctor for your HIV medical care including your lab work. Does not include care from Emergency Room or if you stay in the hospital.
- b) Health Insurance Premium and Cost Sharing Assistance: will pay for medication or doctor visits if you receive a bill.
- c) Oral Health Care: Going to a dentist for care of your teeth and gums.
- d) Mental Health Services: Going to a counselor or therapist to discuss emotional issues in a private visit.
- e) Medical Nutrition Therapy: Must be provided by a licensed, registered dietician and can include nutritional supplements and food.
- f) Substance Abuse Services: Outpatient care to help you quite using drugs. This includes Methadone.
- g) Medical Case Management: Seeing your case manager for help making appointments, developing a care plan, setting up medical appointments, etc.
- h) Housing Services: Help paying your rent. This service is limited to back rent. This service does not allow monthly subsidies to help you pay your rent.
- i) Emergency Financial Assistance: Help paying your electric bill, water bill, etc. This service is limited and is capped at \$1,000 per client per year.
- j) Medical Transportation: Help getting you to any services on this list. If you have Medicaid, you must use Medicaid transportation and not Ryan White transportation.
- k) Health Education/Risk Reduction: Helps clients with HIV learn how to stay health and not give the virus to others
- l) Food Bank/Home Delivered Meals- The provision of actual food items or a voucher program to purchase food
- m) Early Intervention Services- the identification of individuals at points of entry and access to HIV services and includes: 1) HIV Testing and Targeted counseling; 2) Referral services; 3) Linkage to care; 4) Health education and literacy training that enable clients to navigate the HIV system of care
- n) Psychosocial Support Services – Helps clients with support groups for people living with HIV.
