As we close 2024, we're proud to reflect on the growth and impact of our Clinical Quality Management (CQM) program. This year has been defined by change, collaboration, innovation, and measurable improvements in service delivery and outcomes. Through the collective efforts we have placed the highest quality of care for our clients at the forefront of our CQM program and Quality Improvement Projects.

Key Milestones & Achievements (see table below for details)

- 87.5% of our LVTGA agencies completed a Lean Six Sigma Yellow Belt training in January of 2024.
- All agencies completed Cycle 1 Quality Improvement Projects (QIP) and are currently finalizing Cycle 2 QIPs.
- 4 Quarterly Lab Data Day were successfully delivered to Single and Secondary Points of Contact to enhance their ability to pull, inspect, and interpret reports.
- The recipient's Clinical Quality Management Analyst provided 42 capacity building, technical assistance and support sessions to providers this year.

Together, these milestones reflect our collective commitment to quality improvement and achieving better outcomes for the communities we serve.


